A £2.3 million restoration to Key Hill and Warstone Lane cemeteries funded through a partnership between Birmingham City Council, The National Lottery Heritage Fund and the Jewellery Quarter Development Trust. This project aims to restore the cemeteries to their former glory and protect them for future generations. Alongside the restoration work, there will also be an extensive programme of events celebrating their heritage, natural environment and community value. Green Space

A unique day out in one of Birmingham's hidden gems in two Grade II listed landscapes, peaceful havens amid the bustle of the Jewellery Quarter.

Help visitors navigate the cemetery by keeping paths clear and make graves easier to find by keeping the stones free from ivy and other vegetation. Help our native species thrive by keeping the competition at bay.
