Seasonally we'll also be planting native bulbs and flowers to provide a splash of colour and of course food for the bees at the Hive! We'll be working with wildlife and historic environment experts to encourage animals, birds and insects to thrive here in the JQ, whilst protecting the historic features including gravestones.
