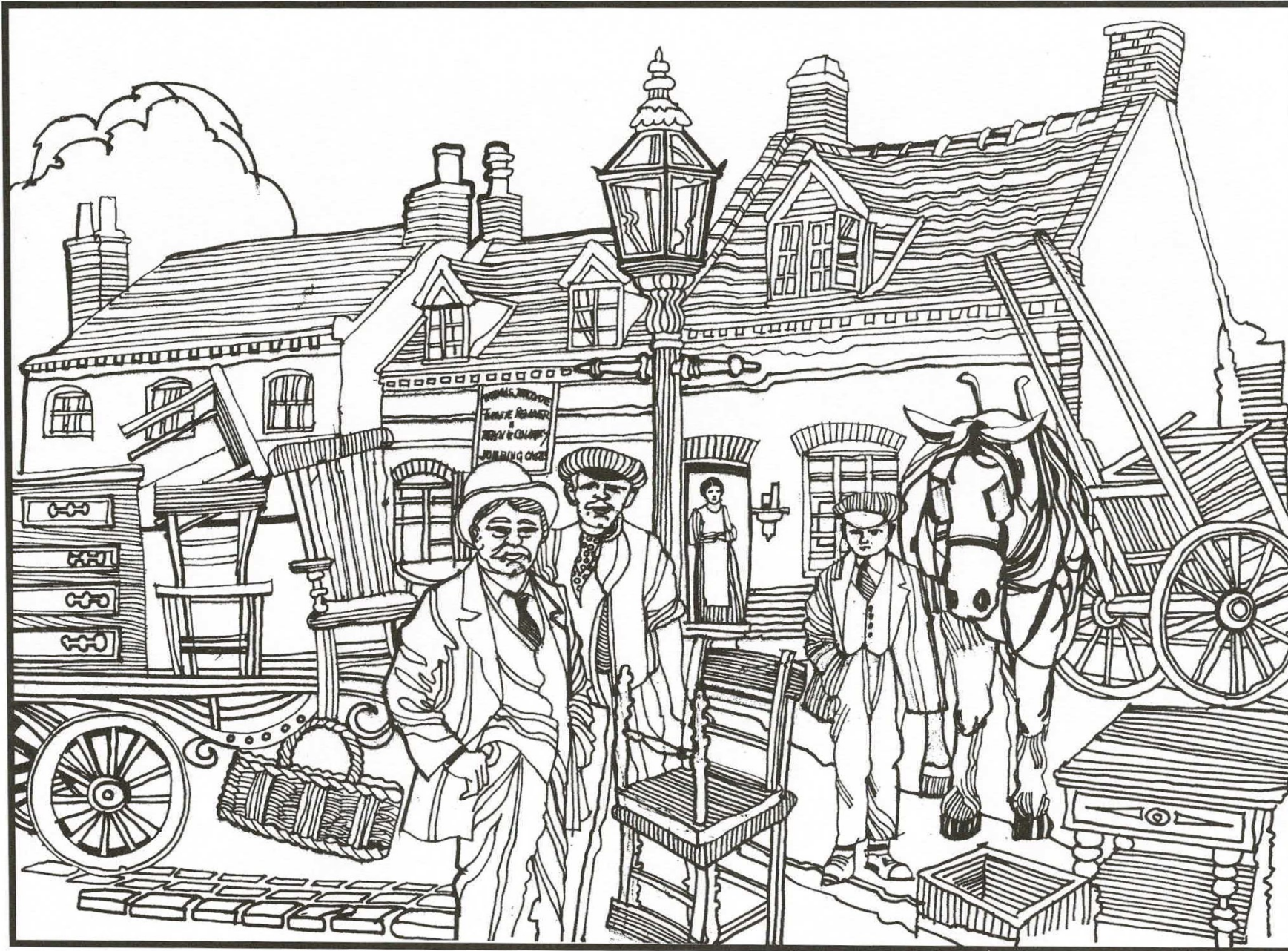


# Thomas Jefcoate Colouring Sheet
